

NOTICE OF RACE

Tempest World Championship 2025

organised by WSV Hoorn
under the auspices of the KNWV
from 16th to 23rd August (inclusive) 2025
location: Hoornse Hop, Hoorn.

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

The notation '[DP]' in a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the race committee without a hearing or a discretionary penalty applied by the protests committee with a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the latest edition of the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)* .and can be found at:

- 1.2 If there is a conflict between languages. The text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.3 The actual Tempest Class rules and the actual Tempest World Championship Rules will apply as defined on <https://www.tempestclass.com> One Crewmember of each participating boat shall be a current member of the ITA recognized National Tempest Association.
- 1.4 Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42 will apply.
- 1.5 Appendix T, Arbitration will apply.
- 1.6 [DP] Each boat is required to comply with RRS 78.1 and the event equipment rules from the time of its pre-race equipment inspection, unless otherwise approved by the Technical Committee.
Non-compliance may be protested and penalised as if it were discovered after racing.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available no later than 5th July 20:00 at www.wsvhoorn.nl.

3 COMMUNICATION

There will be a notice board at the outside of the race office.

- 3.2 [DP] From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the class Tempest. The World Sailing – Eligibility Code (Regulation 19) applies.
- 4.2 Eligible boats shall only enter by completing the entry procedure before 1th of August 0:00 on **manage2Sail** (note: link will follow)
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.4 Competitors that have entered after 31th July 23:59 shall only be accepted after written approval of the Organizing Authority. Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: extra fee of € 100.
- 4.5 The following proof has to be presented at registration:
- Proof of the third-party liability insurance as stated in NoR 21.

5 FEES

- 5.1 An entry fee of € 450,= shall be paid at the time when entering.
- 5.2 The fees are due, even if a boat withdraws the entry later or does not show up. They will only be refunded if the entry is rejected or cancelled by the organizing authority or the race committee or if the event is cancelled or the competitor is prevented from attending due to any governmental regulation.

6 ADVERTISING

- 6.1 [DP][NP] Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, Word Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

7 FORMAT

7.1 The event consists of a single qualifying series.

8 SCHEDULE

8.1 Registration at the race office and Equipment check:

8.2 Program and number of races

Exception: An extra race may be sailed on one day to enable the full number of scheduled races to be completed, providing that the race program has been changed under SI 2.

8.3 The scheduled time of the first warning signal will be:

- For the Practice Race at 12:00 hrs.
- On the first and the following racing days at 11:00 hrs.

8.4 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 15:00 hrs.

8.5 On each racing day a skipper [and support persons] meeting will be held 1,5 hrs before the scheduled first warning signal.

8.6 Social Events to be announced separately.

9 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

9.1 Each boat shall be able to produce a valid measurement certificate or conformity document as required by the class rules.

9.2 [[DP] [NP] Boats shall be available for equipment inspection at the time and place as stated in NoR 8.1.

9.3 DP][NP] Boats may be inspected to comply with the class rules at any time.

10 VENUE

- 10.2 NoR Addendum A shows the plan of the event venue.
- 10.3 NoR Addendum B shows the location of the racing areas.

11 COURSES

- 11.1 The courses to be sailed will be an up-and-down-course preferably with a dogleg at the upper mark and possibly a gate at the lower mark.
- 11.2 The marks will be described in the SI.

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 12.1 RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for RRS 42, will apply.
- 12.2 RRS 44.1 and RRS Appendix P 2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 12.3 Decisions of the International Jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

13 SCORING

- 13.1 The lowpoint system will be applied.
- 13.2 A total of four (4) races are required to be completed to constitute the championship.
- 13.3 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
(b) When 5, 6 or 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
(c) When 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

14 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 14.1 [DP] [NP] Support person vessels shall be registered no later than 14 August, to wedstrijd@wsvhoorn.nl.
A copy of the vehicle registration document shall be attached.
- 14.2 [DP] [NP] Support person vessels and support person vessels drivers shall comply with the legal requirements.
- 14.3 Support person vessels will be part of the security arrangement for the event.

15 CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS

- 15.1 A chartered or loaned boat shall to carry national letters in accordance to the nationality of his person in charge.

16 [DP] BERTHING

16.1 [DP][NP]Boats shall be kept in their assigned places at the venue.

16.2 [DP] [NP] Parking space for trailers is located by the “Evenemententerrein”. See addendum A.

17 LAUNCHING AND HAULING-OUT

17.1 [DP] Boats shall not be hauled out during the event except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

18 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

18.1 [DP] Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the event.

19 DATA PROTECTION AND MEDIA RIGHTS

19.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

19.2 [DP] [NP] If required by the Organizing Authority competitors shall give interviews at the event.

20 RISK STATEMENT

20.1 RRS 3 states: ‘The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.’ By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

20.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

21 INSURANCE

21.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

22 PRICES

22.1 Prices will be given as follows:

- The winners will be awarded the title “World Champion of the Tempest Class”,
- Medals for the boats ranked 1 to 3,
- Prizes for boats ranked 4 to 10,
- Perpetual trophies,
- Souvenir price for each competitor.
